

ICELAND – 7 Nights 8 Days - INR 348,744 PP

Day 1

Upon your arrival at Keflavik International Airport, you will be transferred aboard the Flybus to your hotel. If you arrive early, take your time to explore Reykjavik's colorful streets and cafés on your own.

Day 2:

After breakfast, meet your tour guide and head out for a short tour of Reykjavik. Then, we travel west to Borgarnes and explore the Settlement Center. From there, we continue to Borgarfjörður, where you'll climb the Grábrók volcano crater and visit Deildartunguhver, Hraunfossar, and Barnafoss waterfalls. In the evening, we attend a Northern Lights lecture before heading out for our first aurora hunt.

Day 3

After today's breakfast, we head west to a slice of Iceland that feels absolutely surreal, the Snæfellsnes Peninsula. Stunning coastlines, fishing villages, and the Kirkjufell, easily one of the most photographed mountains in the country. Then, we visit the seaside hamlets of Arnarstapi and Hellnar, before descending 35 metres underground into the Vatnshellir lava cave, a torch-lit tunnel beneath a glacier. Later back at the hotel, your guide shares tips on how to capture the perfect aurora photo, then it's hot tubs, darkness, and another night of Northern Lights again.

Day 4

After breakfast, we make our way around Iceland's most iconic circuit, the Golden Circle. We stop first at Þingvellir National Park, where you can literally stand between two tectonic plates. Then we hit the steaming Geysir geothermal fields, followed by the thunderous Gullfoss waterfall. For lunch, we stop at a local restaurant to taste freshly baked hot spring bread, served with Icelandic butter, boiled eggs, and herring. Afterward, we visit a geothermal greenhouse and meet the famous Icelandic horses. Come nightfall, we're in the countryside, a perfect spot for chasing those Northern Lights again.

Day 5

After breakfast, we begin our journey along Iceland's South Coast. We stop at the Lava & Volcano Exhibition Center first, where you'll learn how this wild island was formed. Then it's on to the Skógar Folk Museum, with turf-roof houses and relics of rural life. We then stop at Skógafoss, a towering waterfall so close you can feel its spray, before ending the day on the hauntingly beautiful black sands of Reynisfjara beach. At night, we check into the hotel near Vatnajökull National Park, deep in darkness, ideal for the aurora.

Day 6

After breakfast, it's time to see one of Iceland's stunning natural wonders, the luminous Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, where massive icebergs float quietly across the water. We also explore the nearby Diamond Beach, where the glacier shimmer like gemstones on black volcanic sand. Then, we'll visit the turf church at Hof and explore Vatnajökull National Park, home to Iceland's tallest peaks and largest glacier. In the evening, we gather for a short film about the Northern Lights, and keep your eyes skyward for another possible display of absolute magic!

Overnight stay in Vatnajökull region

Optional: Between October and April, you can opt for a spectacular ice cave tour inside Vatnajökull glacier (weather permitting).

Day 7

Today, after breakfast, we make our way across the moss-covered Eldhraun lava field to the village of Vík, where sea cliffs and waves make for stunning photos. Then, we take a pause at the ethereal Seljalandsfoss waterfall, famous for the footpath that lets you walk behind its veil. Then, it's time for a classic Icelandic finale, a rejuvenating period in the Blue Lagoon, with milky-blue geothermal water and steam rising all around. By evening, we reach Reykjavik for our final night together.
