

SRILANKA – 7 Nights 8 Days - INR 62,789 PP

Day 1

Welcome to Srilanka! Upon arrival at Colombo Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Dambulla. En route to Dambulla, visit Muneshwaram and Manavari Temple (subject to flight arrival time). Muneshwaram Temple is where Lord Rama, after his battle with King Ravana, sought relief from Brahmahasthi Dosham by installing four lingams, attracting many Hindu devotees. Manavari Temple is the first lingam installed by Lord Rama, also known as Ramalinga Shivan. Proceed to Dambulla and visit the famous Dambulla Cave Temples, a UNESCO-listed rock temple complex dating to the 1st century B.C., featuring a 47-ft recumbent Buddha statue, intricate frescoes, and over 150 life-sized Buddha statues.

Overnight stay in Dambulla.

Day 2

Explore Sigiriya Rock Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a 5th-century "Fortress in the Sky." This iconic Lion Rock features palace ruins, water tanks, ancient frescoes, and stunning gardens. Later, embark on a day tour to Trincomalee to visit Koneswaram Temple, a classical Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, offering breathtaking views of Gokarna Bay. Relax at Nilaveli Beach before returning to Dambulla

Day 3

Travel to Kandy via Mahiyanganaya, visiting Ramayana sites such as Dunuwala, Laggala, Yahangala, Wera Gantota, Sita Kotuwa, and Gurulupotha Lankapura. Arrive in Kandy, the cultural capital of Sri Lanka, nestled at 1,600 ft above sea level. Explore Kandy's rich heritage, including the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, which enshrines Buddha's sacred tooth. Take a city tour, visiting Peradeniya Botanical Gardens, the Royal Palace ruins, and various Hindu shrines.

Overnight stay in Kandy.

Day 4

Depart for Nuwara Eliya, stopping at Ramboda Waterfalls, a stunning three-tiered cascade. Visit the Sri Baktha Hanuman Temple in Ramboda, dedicated to Lord Hanuman, featuring a 16-ft statue. Continue to a tea factory to witness Sri Lanka's renowned tea-making process. Arrive in Nuwara Eliya, also known as "Little England," famous for its colonial architecture, cool climate, and lush tea plantations.

Overnight stay in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 5

Explore Nuwara Eliya, including Victoria Park and Seetha Amman Temple, believed to be where Sita was held captive in the Ashok Vatika. The temple is built by the stream where she is said to have bathed, with footprints attributed to Hanuman. Visit Ashok Vatika, a site of great significance in the Ramayana.

Overnight stay in Nuwara Eliya.

Day 6

Depart for Yala via Ella, stopping at Divurmpola Temple, where Sita underwent her fire ordeal to prove her chastity. Visit Ella, a picturesque town offering attractions such as Ella Gap, Ravana Falls, Ella Rock, Mini Adam's Peak, and the famous Nine Arches Bridge. Explore Ravana Cave, linked to King Ravana's legendary tunnels. Continue to Yala and embark on an exciting safari at Yala National Park, home to elephants, leopards, deer, crocodiles, and diverse birdlife.

Overnight stay in Yala.

Day 7

In the morning, visit Kataragama Temple, a sacred pilgrimage site dedicated to Lord Skanda (Murugan), worshipped by Buddhists, Hindus, and Muslims. En route to Colombo, stop at Ussangoda, an area believed to have been torched by Hanuman and used as an airport by King Ravana. Visit Rumasala, where fragments of the Sanjeevani mountain, carried by Hanuman, are believed to have fallen. Explore Galle, a historic Dutch colonial town featuring a fort, lighthouse, and quaint streets. Visit Sanjeevani Mountain and the Anjaneyar Temple, the only Hanuman temple with a chariot. Continue to Colombo for a city tour covering key landmarks such as the Fort, Pettah Bazaar, the Independence Memorial, and BMICH.

Overnight stay in Colombo.
