Day 1

Day 3

The journey takes approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes, as you travel across frozen landscapes powered by eager huskies, while your luggage is transported separately by vehicle.

Upon reaching your accommodation, settle into your cold room — a beautifully crafted ice suite featuring intricate snow and ice designs. Despite the freezing surroundings, you'll be kept warm with thermal sleeping bags and access to heated facilities nearby. In the evening, savour a gourmet multi-

course dinner that showcases regional flavours from Northern Sweden, served in an intimate and memorable setting.

Note:

- This dog sled transfer must be booked in advance with confirmed flight details and guest clothing sizes.
- Winter gear such as thermal overalls, snow boots, and gloves will be provided on arrival.
- Cold rooms are maintained at approx. −5°C. Guests with medical concerns, pregnant women, or infants are advised to request a warm room in advance, subject to availability.

Day 4

This cultural encounter offers insight into the traditional Sámi way of life, where the indigenous Sámi people have herded reindeer for generations. After a short transfer, visit a Sámi site where you'll have the chance to meet, feed, and interact with the reindeer. An exciting part of the experience includes riding in a wooden sled pulled by a reindeer around a 200-meter fenced track an exhilarating taste of Arctic tradition. The tour concludes with coffee and a taste of the Sámi specialty suovas, served around an open fire inside a traditional Sámi tent. Afterwards, you'll return to your accommodation by short transfer.

- Winter gear such as overalls and snow boots will be provided prior to the reindeer experience.
