Next we to one of the most popular day trips to Montserrat. It is a visit to a unique mountain range offering views over Catalonia. Venture into the Catalan countryside to visit Montserrat on this full-day tour from Barcelona. See the Basilica and Monastery on Montserrat, a beautiful, multi-peak mountain with dramatic rock formations, with free time to continue exploring the museum, farmer's market, or views from the ridge of Cavall Bernat.
